Our Mission and Values:

Learning Help Centers of Charlotte provides scholastic, spiritual and social supports to families mired in generational poverty. Our goal is to promote student success and improve reading, writing, and math proficiency. We endeavor to reverse the trend that indicates that 14% of immigrant children will drop out of high school. This volunteer role is aimed at building relationships and supporting LHCC's goal of providing students with encouragement and mentorship needed to excel in their studies and in life.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Complete an initial 15 to 20-minute orientation to learn our LHCC methodology and best practices, presented by our volunteer coordinator or ED
- Be positive and optimistic, show love and kindness
- Work with assigned student to complete homework assignments (30-45min)
- Read with student to promote literacy engagement (30 min)
- Encourage student in their schoolwork and with a sense of achievement
- Communicate any discipline issues and student progress to our parent and children's coordinators

Time Commitment: Volunteers will meet weekly with students on Tuesday nights from 5:30pm - 6:45pm during the school year. In-Person preferred, but Virtual volunteer opportunities are also available. Other volunteer opportunities on Monday and Thursdays during the school day. Volunteer for a month or quarter, or more

Location: St Andrews Methodist Church, at classrooms near the FLC

Qualifications and requirements: No prior experience needed, just a smile and enthusiasm to work with ELL students in a patient constructive manner. Spanish-speaking abilities helpful, but certainly not required. Must complete a Volunteer Application, Child Protection Policy and Background Check. Some technology experience may be required.

Benefits: This is a great opportunity to mentor an elementary school child from a different culture and gain experience working in education. The rewards are eternal
